D. Expression of Interest for the rental of a building to be used as Village Halls at Nouvelle France and Camp Carol.

- The building should be equipped with utilities, should consist of at least two rooms, a kitchen, a toilet and parking space for at least two vehicles. The building should be accessible to the public at all times.

Instruction to Tenderers

1). A deposit of 10% of the tendered amount by way of banker's cheque drawn in favour of the District Council of Grand Port shall be accompanied with the tender for item A(1-3). The deposit will be returned to unsuccessful bidders.

2) For seized articles (item B2) Bid Bond should be valid for 45 days as from **27 July 2017** in the form of a cash deposit or Bank cheque of Rs 500/- per lot. The Deposit will be returned to unsuccessful bidders.

3). Successful bidders shall effect payment and take delivery of items quoted within **5 days** as from the date of the letter of award, failing which the offer will lapse and the deposit forfeited.

Items A (1-3) will be available/opened to prospective bidders for inspection upon appointment with the Chief Works Inspector during office hours from 09.00hrs to noon and from 13.00hrs to 15.00hrs on phone numbers: 627 4542, 627 7605 or 627 7633.

Bidders are requested to call at the Registry Section, Administration department on weekdays during office hours as from 09.00hrs to collect the relevant bidding documents for items (A) and (D) or for any additional information they may require. Documents for items (B) and (C) may be collected from the Public Health Department.

Eligibility Criteria for item C are as set out in the bidding document.

Submission of bids

Bidders are requested to submit their offers in plain sealed envelopes and bearing no identification of identity but clearly marked "Tender for the Sale of Vehicles/Equipment" or "Tender for seized articles" or "Expression of Interest for the occupation of vacant stalls" or "Expression of Interest for the rental of building at Nouvelle France/Camp Carol" and deposit in the tender box at the Administration Department of the Council on or before Friday 27 July 2017 at 13.00 hrs at latest.

The Council reserves the right to:

- accept or reject any bid and
- Cancel the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without incurring any liability towards the bidder.
