THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT

Regulations made by the District Council of Grand-Port under Sections 122, 158, and 163 of the Local Government Act 2011

1. These regulations may be cited as the District Council of Grand-Port (Fees for Classified Trades) (Amendment) Regulations 2015.
2. In these regulations-
"Principal Regulations" means the District Council of Grand-Port (Fees for Classified Trades) Regulations 2013.
3. Part A of the schedule of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by Part A set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
4. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2015.
