

District Council of **Grand Port (Fair) (Amendment) Regulations 2016**

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT

Regulations made by the District Council of **Grand Port under sections 50, 56, 57, 158,
and 163 of the Local Government Act**

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **District Council of **Grand Port** (Fair) (Amendment) Regulations 2016**.
- 2.** In these regulations -

“principal regulations” means the District Council of **Grand Port** (Fair) Regulations 2013.
- 3.** Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended -
 - (a) in paragraph (2)(e), by adding the words “as specified in schedule D of these regulations”
 - (b) in paragraph (2)(g), by adding the words “as specified in schedule D of this regulations”.
- 4.** Regulation 18 of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by this new section -

18. (1) Any person who contravenes these regulations shall commit an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding 25,000 rupees.

(2) On the conviction of any stall holder and/or agent, the Council may set up a disciplinary committee against the stall holder and/or agent and, on recommendation of the committee, the Council may with the approval of the Ministry -
 - (a) suspend or revoke an authorisation granted under Section 9 (1);
 - (b) vary the terms and condition of an authorisation granted under regulation 9 (1).

(3) Any prosecution under these regulations may be instituted by an inspector or an officer of the Council designated by the Chief Executive.

5. The principal regulations is amended by adding the following new Schedule -


