**(1) EXPRESSION OF INTEREST**

Pursuant to Section 57(1) (a) of the Local Government Act 2011 as subsequently amended, this Council invites expression of interest from members of the public residing within the District Council of Grand-Port area only for the occupation of vacant stalls for a period of *three (3) yearson* such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Council at the:

  - (c) Cake Section - Monday
4. **Plaine Magnien Market**
  - (a) Vegetable Section
  - (b) Fish Section

  - (c) Food/ Cakes Section
6. **Dr James Burtv David market Rose Belle (daily)**

**Submission of Applications**

- (i) Applications forms in plain sealed envelopes should be addressed to the Chief Executive, The District Council of Grand-Port, Royal Road Rose-Belle on or before **18<sup>th</sup> January 2019 by 15hr00 at latest**
- (ii) The envelope should indicate clearly "Expression of Interest" for the occupation of vacant stalls.
- (iii) Only application made through the EOI form will be considered.
- (iv) The Application form for EOI can either be sent by post or be deposited in the EOI box at the Public Health Department of the District Council of Grand Port during working hours on week days.
- (v) Allocation of stalls will be made by drawings of lots on a date, time and place, to be fixed by the Council.
- (vi) Applications received after the specified closing date and time may not be considered.
- (vii) Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the application form will lead to elimination from this exercise.

Please note that only those satisfying the eligibility criteria specified as attached to the application form will be considered.

**(2) TENDER**

This Council invites sealed tenders from members of the public for the following:

- A) **Sale of Vehicles on an "as is where is" basis**
  - (i) Two (2) Scavenging Tipper Lorries 8Z 110 & 8Z 111 make Mitsubishi (Goods Vehicle)
- B) **The right of authorization to occupy vacant Tuck-shops**
  - (i) Seven (7) Tuck-shops at Hollandais street, Mahebourg
  - (ii) Three (3) Tuck-shops at JNH Square, Rose Belle.

- 2) The Tuck-shops may be viewed on appointment with the Senior Health Inspector concerned during office hours on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 9.00hrs to 16.00hrs.
- 3) The Tender Form/Document and other details may be collected at the Registry Section, Administrative Department of the District Council of Grand Port on Working Days as from 10<sup>th</sup> December 2018 between 09.30hrs and 15.00hrs or the application form may be downloaded from the Council's website <https://dcp.mu>
- 4) Tender form should be properly filled & signed and a deposit of 10% of the tendered amount by way of banker's cheque drawn in favour of the District Council of Grand Port shall be accompanied with the tender. Deposit will be returned to unsuccessful bidders.
- 5) Bidders are requested to submit their offer in plain sealed envelopes and bearing no identification of identity but clearly marked "Tender" and should be deposited in the tender box at the Chief Executive Department of the Council on or before 18<sup>th</sup> January 2019 at 15.00hrs
- 6)Successful bidders shall effect payment and take delivery of all items awarded within 5 days as from the date of the letter of award failing which the offer will lapse and the deposit forfeited.
