The District Council of Grand Port is pleased to invite bids from qualified and eligible bidders for the General Sanitation, Street Cleaning, Collection and Carting Away of Solid Waste at Mahebourg Village, Beau Vallon Village, Ville Noire and Blue Bay Localities Including Carting Away Of Post Cyclonic Wastes (for a period of thirty six (36) months) as per requirement contained in the Bidding document.

Participation is limited to Citizens of Mauritius , or entities incorporated in Mauritius. Joint Ventures should be among entities incorporated in Mauritius

Bidders shall be registered with the Ministry of Local Government and Disaster Risk Management as Scavenging Contractor

The procurement is being conducted through Open National Bidding procedures according to the provisions of the Mauritius Public Procurement Act 2006 as amended.

Bids must be submitted online on the e-Procurement System on Wednesday 09 December 2020 up to 13.30 hours (Mauritian Time) at latest.

Bidders who have submitted bids online by the closing date and time shall decrypt and re-encrypt their bids on Wednesday 09 December 2020 as from 14:31 hours till Friday 11 December 2020 at 14:00 hours

Bids shall be opened online on the e-Procurement System on Friday 11 December 2020 as from 14:01 hours up to 18:00 hours in the Conference Room of the Central Procurement Board in the presence of Bidders/Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address mentioned below.
