Bids must be submitted online on the e-Procurement System on Monday 22 March 2021 up to 13.00 hours (Mauritian Time) at latest.

Bidders who have submitted bids online by the closing date and time shall decrypt and re-encrypt their bids on Monday 22 March 2021 as from 16.01 hours till Tuesday 23 March 2021 up to 13.00 hours

Bids shall be opened online on the e-Procurement System on Tuesday 23 March 2021 as from 13:01 hours
